



## Rules

### Participants:

Each team must have 6 participants plus 1 alternate. The team will name a captain who will write the answers.

### Questions:

There are 90 questions; each question will have a value inside parenthesis. There will not be any half points. If we have a bad question or there is a mistake, we will null the question and no other question will be added.

### Time:

There will be 10 seconds given to answer each question with a regular answer and 15 to 20 seconds for a question with a long answer.

### Score Keeper:

The score keeper will grade the answers. In case that an answer is questionable or is not complete, the score keeper should raise his hand and a person will take the answer to the panel who will determine if the answer is correct or incorrect and assign the points.

### Process:

- The question will be displayed on the screen. We will read the question in English and then in Spanish, taking turns to read them in both languages. At this point, the time will start.
- The timekeeper will give the answer to the captain, who will write it down.
- When the time is announced, the captain will pass the answer to the score keeper.
- The answer will be displayed on the screen.
- The score keeper of each team will write down the points on the score sheet.
- If the answer is correct, the score keeper will write down the point value. For example, write 1, if it was a one point question; write 2, if it was a 2 point question.
- If the answer is incorrect, write down a 0 (zero).
- The score keeper will show the captain what he wrote down. If the captain has a doubt, he can ask the score keeper to send the answer to the panel of judges, who will resolve the doubt immediately.
- We will take a 5 minute break after 30 questions. The score keeper can count the points here and write the subtotals on the score sheet.
- At the end of the contest, the score keeper of each team will take to the panel the answer sheets and the score sheet.

### Evaluation

- We will inform the results at the end of the contest; this will take about 15 to 20 minutes.
- The teams that have more than 90% of the questions correct will be in first place and will continue to the next level Bible Bowl.
- In the case of no team reaching the 90% mark, we will take the highest score and calculate the 90% using that score as a base.
- Second place will be 80% to 89%.
- Third Place will be below 79%.
