

## Hunting Hollow Guided Wildflower Ride 2009

The wildflowers in bloom at Henry Coe are usually spectacular in the Spring. Enjoy a ride and learn the names of some of these flowers.

**Date:** Saturday, April 4<sup>th</sup>

**Time:** Please arrive by 9:30 so that we can ride out by 10am and be back at the trailers before 3pm

**Where:** The Hunting Hollow Entrance to Henry Coe State Park

**Terrain:** There are two options and weather will determine whether we do a mostly flat route with as many as 52 creek crossings (that may be up to 2 feet deep), or a long climb up Lyman Willson Ridge to Wilson Camp.

**Total miles:** 8-10 miles at the walk depending on the route.

**Weather:** Rain cancels the ride

**Cost:** \$4.00 usage fee for the Iron Ranger

**Destination:** Down Hunting Hollow to The Kickham Ranch and back the same way or to Willson Camp and back mostly the same way. You may be offered a choice too!

**Bring:** Your lunch, a halter with lead line and cash for the usage fee

**Reminder:** Do not leave manure or shavings in the parking lot
