Do I need to schedule my exam before coming to the Center?

Scheduling and payment are required prior to taking your exam. Please call the Certification Center at 317-917-5991 to schedule and pay for your exam. To ensure proper processing time, please call at least 24 hours in advance to schedule.

We will send you a confirmation email after you have scheduled your exam. The email will contain a map and driving directions.

How much does it cost to take the exam?

The current exam fee is \$15 per exam. Payment is due at time of registration. Credit card payment is preferred. We'll be glad to discuss other payment options, such as company-sponsored payment or paying by cash, when you call.

When are the exams given?

Testing is conducted year-round with hours available Monday - Saturday

I'm an instructor, can I schedule my class to test as a group?

Yes, we will work with instructors to do group testing at our campus. Give us a call at 317-917-5991 and we will be glad to work with you and your students.

What do I need to bring with me to the Workforce Certification Center?

You will need to bring a valid (non-expired) Driver's License or State ID Card. You will also need to bring your valid PSID card, or be able to provide your PSID number.

Call us at 317-917-5991 if you have questions about proper ID.

What can I take into the exam room with me?

You will only be allowed to bring in your ID center-provided earplugs and center-provided scratch paper into the testing room. Some exams also allow center-provided calculators to be brought in. We will ask that all personal belongings (wallets, keys, change, cell phones, etc.) be stored in our secure lockers or kept in your vehicle during testing. All electronic devices must be turned off before securing in our lockers.
