Be sure to download all three (3) pages of the app.

Completed applications should be received **only** by the Chairman by placing directly in his hands, mailing to his home address, which can be found below, or via attachment to my e-mail address noted above. This is to ensure they are received and recorded with the date of receipt. It is solely the applicant's responsibility to ensure completed applications are received by the **Chairman** by the due date, **Saturday, 18 April 2009**.

Eligibility:

- a. Son, daughter, or grandchild of an active or deceased member of Post 284 with at least three (3) years of continuous membership in Post 284.
- b. High school senior or attending or accepted at an accredited post secondary institution.
- c. Must have a **2.0** or better GPA to be considered.
- d. Submission of 500 word essay on the following: Our Country just participated in a significant event in It's history, the election of Barack Obama as our President . How do you feel this event will affect our Country politically and socially in the next 5 years?
- e. Most recent transcript must be included with the application. Do not wait for second semester grades to be added.
- f. Submit a list of school extra-curricular activities, community, and church involvement. College freshman should submit both their high school and college activities.
