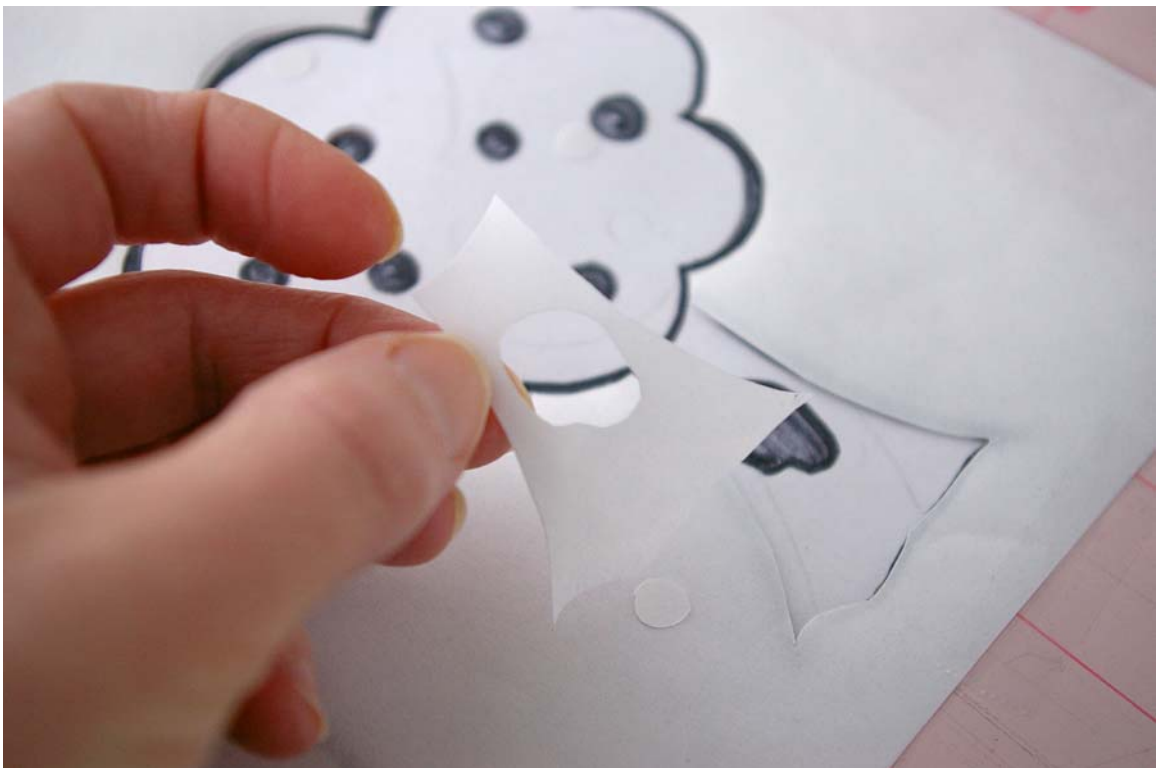
This is a step by step photo tutorial to show how I created the more complicated house and tree freezer paper stencil image.



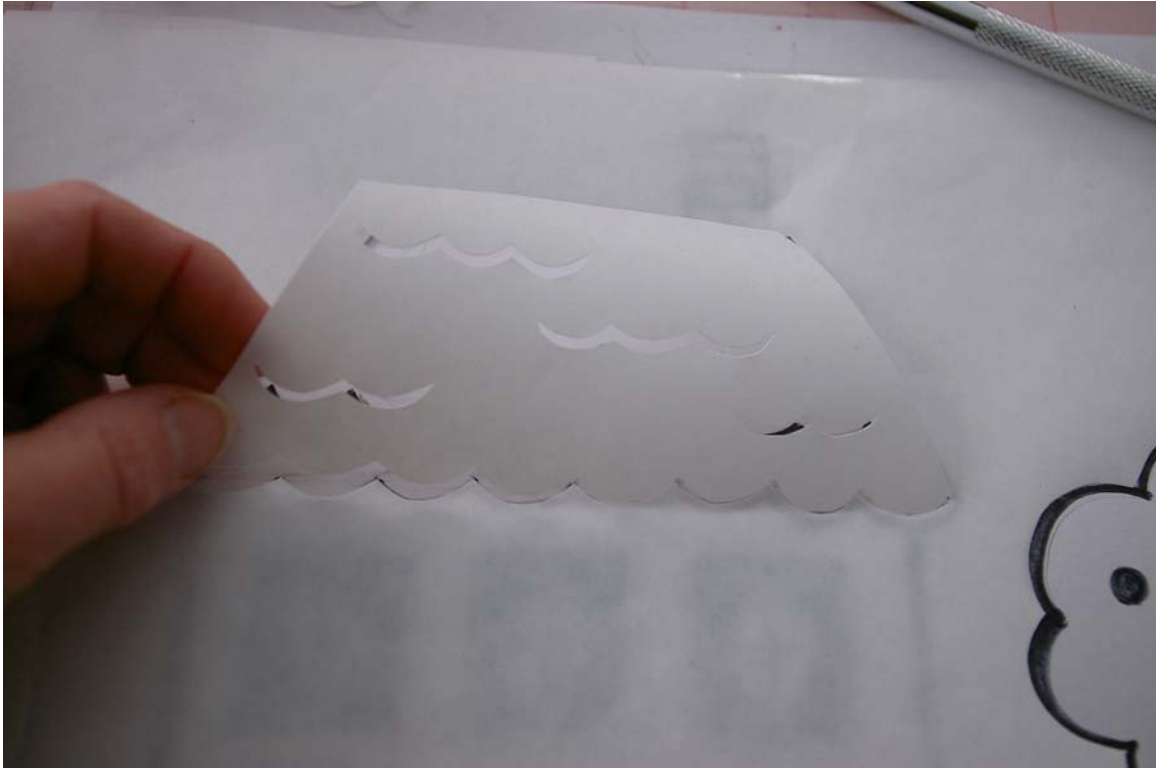
I began by cutting out the center of the tree as well as the apples. I kept the tree center and one apple (for the house door knob) in a safe spot to use later.



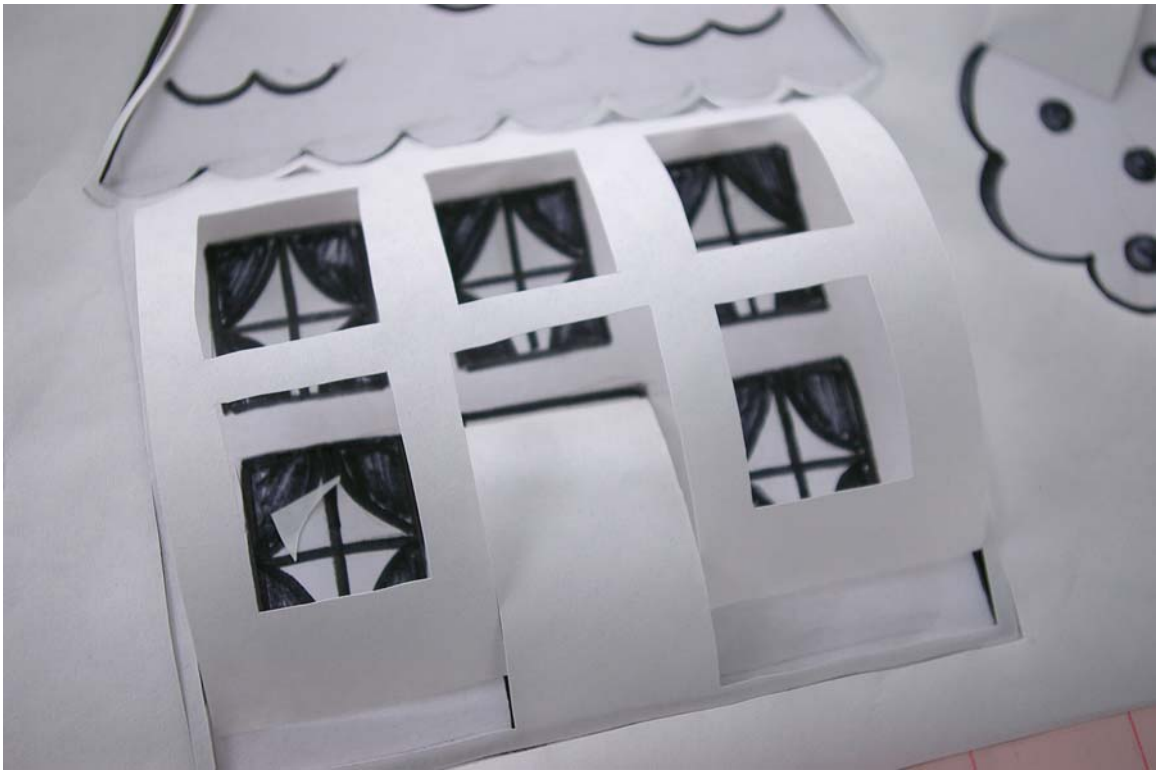
Next I cut out the thickness of the outline and discarded it.



Then I did the same thing with the trunk: first cutting out the center hole and discarding it, then cutting out the trunk and reserving it, then cutting out the thickness of the outline and discarding it.



I followed the same procedure for the house.





I ironed on the background portion of the stencil to the fabric.



Then I ironed on all the reserved shapes.
The stencil is ready for paint!



Here is the end result.
