WHO: Open to any swimmer 17 years of age or younger (age as of 12/1/06).  
The Meet Director reserves the right to limit the number of swimmers.

EVENT LIMITS: Each swimmer may enter 6 events, 1 of which must be a relay.

ENTRY FEES: \$3.00 per individual event ◇◇◇◇◇ \$12.00 per relay team

AWARDS: Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in all events. Medals will be awarded to 4th, 5th, 6th places and ribbons to 7th, 8th, and 9th places in all events. Trophies will be awarded to the overall 1st and 2nd place Girls and Boys Team. Host team is not eligible. Trophies will be awarded to the high point winner in each age group. Heat awards will be given to the winner of each heat.
