Dear Mr. Rust:

This letter is about your support of The National Council of La Raza, a racist hate group. These are pictures are taken from the local newspaper of the student protest at Montebello High School in CA. on March 28. Yes, that is the American flag flying upside down beneath the Mexican flag.

Now lets talk about the consequences of your sponsorship of La Raza. My school district is bankrupt. Our ER hospital in Downey has now closed, one of 86 in CA. closed because of illegal immigration. We have 40, 000 illegal aliens in CA. prisons and spend \$10 billion dollars annually on health, education and other social services for illegal aliens. My kid gets cheated in education while you help a racist group violate American law and undercut the wages of American workers turning our country into a third world sewer. If your doubt the political stand of La Raza on the recent demonstrations, go to their web site.

Insurance companies love statistics. Check the CA Dept. of Education web site and you will find that in the Montebello school district, where the protest took place, there are 14, 042 English learners by language Spanish. The next group is Cantonese at 98. That's right, 14,042 vs 98. How could that happen? Maybe you'd best ask La Raza about what's going on at the border and their role in it. Maybe you'll ask the unscrupulous employer who hires illegal aliens and uses the American middle class to subsidize the cost while their own jobs are insourced. Maybe you'll step up and help my bankrupt school district . Do you realize that the cost to educate those 14,042 fine upstanding illegal aliens at \$7000/ year is \$98,000,000! Do you understand the magnitude of the grief you are causing?

Enough. We all feel legal immigrants are welcome to our country. All of us have our roots from some place else. This is not a race issue. Let me know if you'd like to speak to many Hispanic Americans who feel the same way. State Farm will not use my money to fund La Raza. Nor will I accept your phony explanation that you are only funding education and community activities. Look again at the pictures. There's your community education program. You know exactly what you are doing and you are doing it thinking you'll make money off the investment. Your agent, *Agent's Name* feels as I do. I would ask him to step up and be heard on the issue. Ask him about the student marches. Ask him about the uninsured motorist part of this equation. How many accidents are caused by illegal aliens who flee the scene or just tell you they have no insurance. We end up paying for that in increased rates. Think of the terrorism aspect of the open border. Where does State Farm think the Families of 9/11 Victims stands on this issue? 3000 dead in New York and your company has no concerns? My guess is that my policy doesn't cover things like a dirty bomb going off in the neighborhood. Again you help cause the problem by helping others to break the laws then leave me to deal with the consequences. Did you send a sympathy card to the family of Los Angeles Deputy Sheriff David March who was executed by illegal alien Armando Garcia who then fled to Mexico? I'm betting you didn't.

This is a business decision for you. But it also says much if State Farm doesn't care about the concerns of their sales agent either. If State Farm is going to hurt me, my family, community and country, you are going to do it on your dime, not mine. You are NOT a "good neighbor" when you support La Raza.

You do not want to hear from me first. You are not going to continue tearing down my neighborhood with my money. Three policies will be gone along with my loyalty for many years. I hope you'll decide to support something like a children's hospital or Katrina victims instead.
