



Olney Kehila Membership and School Registration

Membership

2009 Membership and Tuition at 2008 Rates – Olney Kehila's membership and tuition fees are not increasing for the 2009-2010 school year.

- Family membership: \$800
- Individual membership: \$600
- Senior Citizen family fee of \$600
- Senior Citizen individual fee of \$400

Hebrew School

- **Tuition:** \$800 per student
- **Registration Non-refundable Deposit:** \$160 per student. The \$160/student deposit counts toward your tuition balance.
- **Early Registration Discount:** subtract \$200 per student. Olney Kehila must receive your completed enrollment forms and a nonrefundable deposit of \$160 per student **by May 1, 2009**.
- **Registration example 1:** if you register **by** May 1, 2009 with a deposit of \$160, your remaining balance will be $\$600 - \$160 = \$440$ per student.
- **Registration example 2:** if you register **after** May 1, 2009 with a deposit of \$160, your remaining balance will be $\$800 - \$160 = \$640$ per student.
- **Membership Required** – All new members and returning members must complete the Membership Registration form for the 2009-2010 year. Membership in Olney Kehila is required for Hebrew School enrollment. The membership form is included in this package.

Payment Plans

- A **four-part installment plan** is available for membership and tuition fees, with payments due as follows:
 - First payment – due July 15, 2009
 - Second payment – due September 15, 2009
 - Third payment – due November 15, 2009
 - Fourth/final payment – due February 15, 2010
- A **monthly installment plan** is available for membership and tuition fees, with payments due as follows:
 - First payment – due July 1, 2009
 - Second payment – due August 1, 2009
 - Third payment – due September 1, 2009
 - Fourth payment – due October 1, 2009
 - Fifth payment – due November 1, 2009
 - Sixth payment – due December 1, 2009
 - Seventh payment – due January 1, 2010
 - Eighth/final payment – due February 1, 2010

Financial Assistance, Referral Fees and Contact Information

Financial Assistance – If you are unable to pay the full tuition fee for your child, you may request financial assistance from Olney Kehila by contacting the President or Treasurer of the Board of Trustees.

Referral Fee – The Olney Kehila offers a \$36 credit to your membership account for a referral that results in a new family enrolling one or more students in the Hebrew School.
