You read it right! A \$50 finder fee for **YOU!**

The Tomahawk Lions are offering a **\$50 finder fee** for any active (paid up) member who contracts a business or advertiser to have information displayed on the iShow tri-screen system at Lemke's Foods. The cost of this ad is just \$30 a month (a dollar a day) with a 3 month minimum contract. (Annual payments receive a one month discount.) The system (at this time) is limited to 30 ads of 30 seconds each. This means the ad will repeat every 15 minutes 24/7. Assuming all 30 ads contract for one year, \$330 minus the \$50 finder fee equals \$280. \$280 times 30 advertisers equals \$8,400 a year of income for the Tomahawk Lions Administrative Fund. Also, because the funds go to the Lions club, all ads are tax deductible – be sure to mention this!

The money goes to the **Lions Administrative Fund**. Therefore it can be used to pay for non-activity expenses that, in the past, had to be borrowed from time to time from the activity fund. Any excess money in the Administrative Fund at the end of the year can be moved to the activity fund and then could be distributed to area service clubs and organizations.

This is a **WIN, WIN, WIN** situation. Some people will buy an ad because they want their name out there. Some will buy an ad because it is so low cost. Some will buy an ad because it is a deduction. Some will buy an ad because it is for the Lions. Some will buy an ad because of all the above. So the **BUSINESS WINS, YOU WIN, and the LIONS WIN!** Call Lion President Orrin Kolberg for application form.

Last year we were \$1,300 over budget because of four unexpected but necessary and approved distributions. With these additional funds in the Administration Fund, we can continue to provide funds to our community without fear of strain on our members to do additional work or cut these needed contributions.
