This form is for use in Elkhart County for permission to use the official clover. The official 4-H clover is protected by the USDA as a trademark. It can be used by 4-H entities with permission only.

This permission can be granted by;

- Clovers that include reference to Elkhart County or a specific 4-H club or Elkhart County project can be approved by the Elkhart County Extension office, 4-H Youth Development educators.
- Clovers designated as Indiana 4-H must be submitted to the State 4-H office.
- Clovers without designation must be submitted to the National 4-H office.
