

TENT CLEANING

Troop tents must be cleaned and dried after each campout.

- SHAKE ALL DIRT OUT OF TENT
 - IF COVERED WITH DIRT -- USE HOSE AND WATER TO CLEAN
 - SET UP TENT IN A DRY LOCATION AND ALLOW TO DRY
 - DO NOT PACK TENT EVEN IF JUST SLIGHTLY DAMP !!!
 - PACK TENT AND RETURN TO TROOP QUARTERMASTER
 - NOTIFY QUARTERMASTER OF ANY DAMAGE OR MISSING PARTS
 - each tent should have: - tent body - 10 stakes - 5 main poles - pole bag
 - rain fly - 2 dog bones - 2 end poles - stake bag
 - vestibule - ground cloth - tent bag
 - NEVER USE WASHING MACHINE OR DRY CLEAN A TENT !!!

FOOD BOX CLEANING

Grubmaster must clean ice chest and dry goods box after the campout.

- ICE CHEST MUST BE SCRUBBED OUT AFTER EACH CAMPOUT
 - scrub using a mix of soap and a few drops of Clorox with warm water
 - rinse several times with clean water and leave open to dry
- CLEAN DIRT OUT OF DRY GOODS BOX
- DISCARD ALL PERISHABLES
- KEEP NON-PERISHABLES FOR NEXT CAMPOUT
- SCRUB OUTSIDE OF BOXES TOO
- RETURN BOTH BOXES TO TROOP QUARTERMASTER
