NEW POLICY: Deadline for registration is October 15, 2008

Projected Leagues:

Introductory: Boys & Girls - 2 nd Grade Co-Ed	
Instructional: Boys - 3 rd Grade	Girls - 3 rd Grade
Intermediate: Boys - 4 th Grade	Girls - 4 th Grade
Minors: Boys - 5 th Grade	Girls - 5 th Grade
Majors: Boys - 6 th , 7 th & 8 th Grades	Girls - 6 th & 7 th Grades
Seniors: Boys - 9 th to 12 th Grades	Girls - 8 th to 12 th Grades.

These are **PROJECTED** Leagues and may be changed based on the number of interested players and available coaches for each division.

Boys Major Leagues are currently being planned as separate individual divisions.

Introductory League — 2nd Grade - Boys and Girls Co-Ed

An eight week program which runs Saturdays during January and February. Players have the benefit of all coaches and learn the basic skills and rules of the game. Season finale includes a formal game and a trophy and ice cream party.

Instructional League - 3rd Grade - Boys and Girls

Advanced introductory league which runs Saturdays during January and February consisting of 5 weeks of instruction and 3 weeks of games. Progression into games will be at the decision of the League. Season finale includes a trophy and ice cream party.

**** All 3rd Grade players may elect to play in the Introductory League instead. (See registration form)**

Intermediate League - 4th Grade - Boys and Girls

Advanced instructional league which runs Saturdays during January and February consisting of 2 weeks of instruction and 6 weeks of games. Progression into games will be at the decision of the League. Season finale includes a trophy and ice cream party.

**** All 4th Grade players may elect to play in the Instructional League instead. (See registration form)**

Minor Leagues - Boys - 5th Grade Girls - 5th Grade

Competitive, non-coed leagues with adapted rules for safety.

Major Leagues - Boys - 6th, 7th & 8th Grades Girls - 6th & 7th Grades

Competitive, non-coed leagues with adapted rules for safety.

Senior League - Boys - 9th to 12th Grades Girls - 8th to 12th Grades

Competitive non-coed leagues with high school rules.

Includes an All-Star game at the end of season.

2008 – 2009 Player and Parent Agreement

I am a player in the Bob Cort Youth Athletic Association and I know that I must follow some important rules in order to be a member of the league. My parent(s), guardian(s) also agree to abide by these rules. It is my responsibility to ensure that my friends and family who come to see me are also aware of these rules. I understand that if I or any of the above listed people fail to abide by these rules, it can lead to my being suspended from the league.

A. I will follow the directions of the security guards, Lacey Recreation Dept. staff, custodians, coaches, referees, and any other B.C.Y.A.A. supervisor or officer. I agree to immediately leave the gymnasium or school building if so directed by any of these people.

B. I promise to leave all food and drink in the car. Players only are permitted water bottles behind the bench area. I'll pick up any trash that I see and put it in the cans in the school.

C. Basketballs can be carried to the gym for practices but never for a game. I will dribble, pass and shoot in the gym only, not in the hallways or against any school walls, inside or outside.

D. I will not invite my friends to come to my practices. If they were with me, I would have to practice and watch them at the same time.

E. I am allowed to go on the court on game days during my pre-game lay-ups, at my game halftime, and during the game, but not at any other time. My family and I must sit in the stands, never on the wrestling mats.

F. Wearing jewelry could injure someone when playing basketball. I will *not* wear rings, bracelets, necklaces, earrings, and *especially watches* to practices or games. Since a brimmed hat could also hurt someone, I will not participate while wearing one.

G. **B.C.Y.A.A. will not tolerate violations of its Flagrant/Malicious Foul, Drug, Alcohol, Tobacco policy. The first violation carries a one game suspension, a second violation carries expulsion from the league for the balance of the season.**

I understand that breaking these rules (especially Rules A and G) could become serious and lead to my suspension from the basketball program.

Parental/Guardian Obligations If Chosen For Team

- 1) All Traveling Team players must be registered with BCYAA - 7th and 8th grade boys and girls may choose not to play on a BCYAA recreational team. All BCYAA players have the opportunity to tryout for each appropriate team.
- 2) Additional registration fees for traveling team players are \$75 in addition to regular BCYAA registration fees. These fees cover traveling team insurance costs and registration in up to four tournaments. Additional fees may be required if a respective team registers in additional tournaments.
- 3) Mandatory 3 - 5 hours per family volunteer time at the Lacey Tournament scheduled for the first 2 weeks in December. If parents do not volunteer during the Lacey Tournament, they will be required to pay an additional fee of \$20.00.
- 4) Transporting of athletes to out-of-town tournaments.
- 5) Tryouts provide an opportunity for all BCYAA players to demonstrate their skills for consideration by the coaches.
These teams play competitively!!! Coaches have no obligation to play everyone.
- 6) Traveling team practices will begin in November and may continue throughout the year depending on ability to register for a tournament.

*If you are trying out for a Traveling Team you have an option
-If you are selected for a traveling team you have the choice of playing on
B.C.Y.A.A. Recreation or not.*
