ACCOMMODATIONS

DORMS Most of the rooms are set up to house individual families. A limited number of rooms are furnished with a double bed, three bunks and complete rest room. Rest room facilities for other rooms are in an adjacent building.

LODGE The lodge has nine rooms furnished with a double bed and one single bed. Lodge rooms have wash basins in each room with complete rest rooms just down the hall.

Electrical and water hook-ups are available to accommodate R.V. units.
