

## **Emotion:**

recognition of an event + recognition of my relation to that event + something else

---

## **Intuition: a particular feeling that is often provided as a source of knowledge**

- Core Intuitions

Reason and Perception ultimately depend on intuition

Examples:

Nothing comes from nothing

I exist

$1 + 1 = 2$

You should not torture animals for the fun of it

---

- Subject Specific Intuitions

Usually our familiarity with specific subjects influences our intuition

Examples:

Which sequence of heads and tails is more likely?

H - T - H - T - H - T

H - H - H - H - H - H

you are holding a loaded gun in one hand and a bullet in the other so that the gun and the individual bullet are at the same height. Assume that you are standing on a flat plain and there are no objects in your path of fire. Fire the gun and drop the bullet at the same time. Which of the two bullets will hit the ground first?
