

N.O.R.A. 2009 Off-Road Racing Guidelines

General Car/Race Specs

Electric

All STOCK Electric Classes are limited to 27 Turn Roar Stock Motor (No Bearings) or 17.5 Brushless Motor
Note 13.5 Brushless Motor is Mod or Pro Stock depending on number of entries.

MOD Electric Classes may run any Turn Brushed or Brushless motor.

All Electric Classes are limited to a maximum of 4600mah 6 cell Sub C Batteries or 8000mah 2 Cell 7.4v LiPo. (Hard Case Only)

Electric Class Heats are 6 minutes and Mains are 7 minutes.

Reverse is not allowed. (Penalties will be imposed.)

Gas/Nitro

Gas Engine Size Limits by class – 1/10 Truck (.12-.15), 1/8 Buggy (.21), 1/8 Truggy (.21-.28), Monster Truck(Unlimited)

Monster Trucks will run with Truggies

Gas Class Heats are 5 minutes, A-Mains are 15 minutes, and all lower mains are 5 minutes.

All Gas Engines (Nitro) Must have a Throttle Return Spring.

No Electric conversions for Gas Class.

Gas & Electric

3 or more entries required to run the class.

Each Class will have 2 Heat races and a Main event.

Aerodynamics- NO METAL Wings, Spoilers.

Corner Marshaling –

You MUST corner marshal for the race immediately after your race.

If you are unable to corner, you must find a qualified substitute (racers or members only) to take your place.

Please corner marshal to your best ability, as if it were your car that needs marshaling.

Transponders/Frequency Flags –

All transponders and frequency flags MUST be returned immediately after each race – Before you Corner Marshal.

If you have a 27Mhz or 75Mhz radio system you must have a frequency flag in order to turn your radio on.

Remember – DO NOT turn on your radio unless you have a frequency flag! Frequency flags will be supplied by the track.

2.4Ghz DSM radio systems do not require frequency flags, but must be registered at the computer for racing.

House Transponders are available at the track.

If House Transponders are taken from the track, the following penalties will be enforced: \$25 late fee \$125 if lost.

Drivers may choose to provide their own AMB personal transponder.

General

You are responsible for the Safety of your Equipment.

Must bring your own Pit Table, Chair, Extension Cord and Power Strip.

Pack out your own garbage.

Work Parties for Track Maintenance will be announced. Please come help. Remember you keep the track going!

Burlington Parks Dept. has requested NO Propane BBQ's.

Race Fees –

Members pay - \$10.00 for 1st class + \$5.00 each additional class.

Non-Members/Guests pay: \$12.00 for 1st class + \$6.00 each additional class.

Rookie/Novice Classes pay: \$6.00 each.

Annual Membership Fees: \$15.00 individual + \$10.00 each additional family member.

Conduct

This is a family oriented club, so control your behavior, as children are often nearby.

Angry outbursts & Unsportsmanlike Conduct will not be tolerated. Rough Driving & Intentional Bumping will not be tolerated.

Suspension and/or expulsion may result, and is at the discretion of the Race Director/Board.

N.O.R.A. reserves the right to deny membership and/or participation in or at any Club/Race event.

Drugs and Alcohol will not be permitted at any N.O.R.A. racing events. Violators will be asked to leave.
