How:

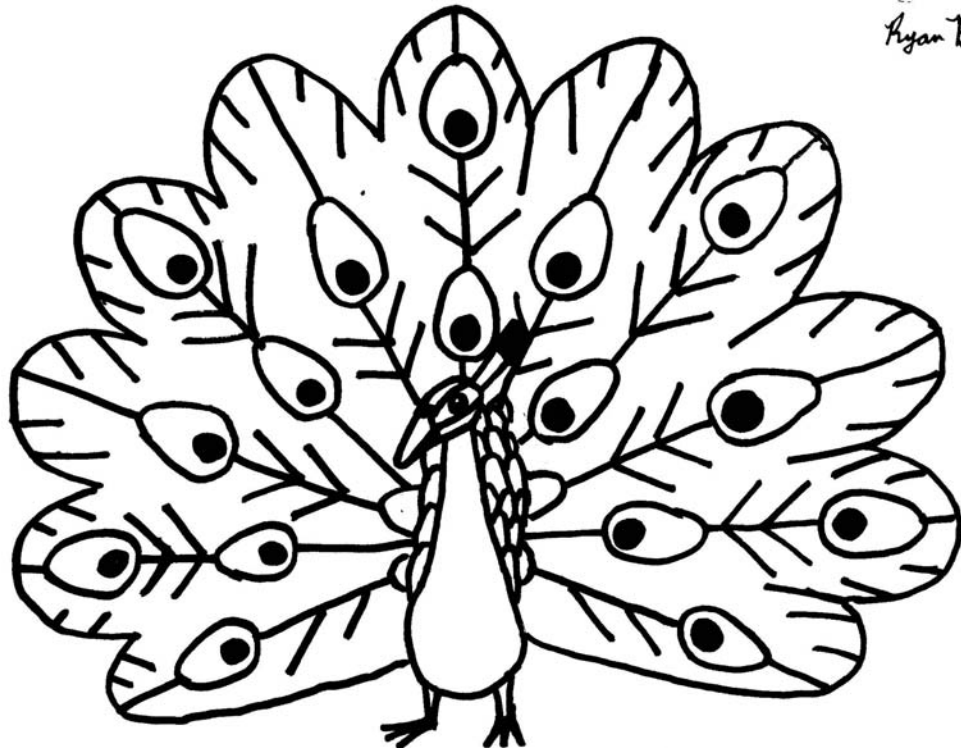
1. (optional) Color in the below peacock or draw one of your own.
