**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW HOPE,  
COUNTY OF BUCKS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA  
SUPPORTING THE ENACTMENT OF PENNSYLVANIA SENATE BILL 977,  
REQUIRING AN AUDITABLE VOTER-VERIFIED PERMANENT PAPER  
RECORD OF EACH VOTE**


Whereas, Pennsylvania Senate Bill 977, Printer's Number 1310, would amend the Pennsylvania Election Code to require each election district that uses an electronic voting system to produce or require the use of an auditable voter-verified permanent paper record of the voter's vote that must be made available for inspection and verification by the voter before the voter's vote is cast; and

Whereas, the Council of the Borough of New Hope, Bucks County, Pennsylvania wishes to support the enactment of Senate Bill 977.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Borough of New Hope, County of Bucks, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that the Council endorses Pennsylvania Senate Bill 977 and supports the provisions of the bill requiring an auditable voter-verified permanent paper record of each individual's vote.
