On behalf of the Executive Board I would like to extend a thank you to Dennis Furey for his many years of service as treasurer of SBIC. We welcome Eric Bittel as newly elected treasurer and look forward to his contribution to the board. The Executive Board members work diligently to insure that your experience as a member of SBIC is competitive, enjoyable, and fair.

What's new? A change in the tie-breaking procedures has been adopted for the SBIC tournaments. This will be explained at the opening meeting. Additionally, the Executive Board has decided to go back to a three-tee system. Men (under 70) will tee off from the back, Seniors (70 & over) the middle, and all Women from the forward tees.

Important: under the SBIC By-Laws, section 10, the Executive Board is requesting a vote from the membership present at the annual meeting to amend the SBIC Constitution By-Laws.

Also, there will be a Texas Hold'em tournament, Friday, February 27, at the New Sandy Burr Golf Club. Not a player, come and socialize. See enclosed invitation for more information.
