
Summer Camp 2009

When: 5 - 11 July 2009 (Sunday to Saturday)

Cost: \$255.00 per Scout

Where: Camp Olmsted / Goshen, Virginia

Summer Camp is one of the premier events of the Boy Scout year. This is where Scouts get to camp out with their friends, earn Merit Badges, and do all sorts of other fun Scouting activities. Summer Camp is recommended for Scouts through the rank of Life (and even Eagle Scouts). It is almost essential for first year Scouts. Goshen offers a first year camper program which allows the younger Scouts to work on requirements through 1st Class as well as earn a couple of Merit Badges. Summer Camp is also where older Scouts earn most of their Merit Badges.

We will be attending Camp Olmsted this summer. Summer Camp will cost approximately \$255 if paid by 20 April. After which, the price will increase to approximately \$305 until 1 June. After June 1st, the "AT CAMP" price will be approximately \$325. NOTE: These costs do not include bus transportation to/from Goshen. Sign-up prior to March 9th and you will receive a free Goshen ball cap.

Medical Forms: There is a new medical form that replaces both of the older medical forms. It will be required after January 1, 2010. For 2009, this form as well as the older Class 1&2 and Class 3 Medical forms are all approved for use by the National Office. For convenience, anyone having a physical this year for team sports, travel, etc. should use the new form. Class 1 and 2 medical forms are required for all Scouts and adults under 40 years of age. Adults over 40 are required to have a Class 3 form that must be updated every year.
