FIRST THINGS FIRST

While our capital campaign prepares us for our future, your annual stewardship pledge is what powers the many activities that fill our buildings, week after week, all through the year. Before making your capital campaign pledge, please prayerfully consider how you will support next year's operating budget through a stewardship pledge.

ESSENTIAL GIFTS TO RAISE \$276,000

To raise our capital campaign goal, gifts of every size are essential. The following table shows the gifts we will need to raise \$276,000.

ACCESSIBILITY

Install a ramp and sidewalk with hand railing from the parking lot to the Sanctuary to improve access to the church. Install electrically operated, push-button doors at the Sanctuary and Parish Hall entrances for greater accessibility for those with limited mobility. \$15,000

OUTDOOR LIGHTING

Replace existing outdoor lighting with more powerful fixtures and install additional fixtures to illuminate the parking lot and grounds to provide safe access to and from the church. \$6,000

ROOF

Our roof is in serious disrepair. Many of the shingles have deteriorated, causing leaks and the potential for structural damage. The roof is not insulated, which results in lost heat, leading to formation of ice dams under the shingles, water damage, and dangerous icicles. Removal of the existing roof, replacement with more durable 50-year shingles, repair of the underlayment, and installation of new insulation will reduce energy costs and help ensure the building's integrity. \$84,000

SIDING

The existing wooden clapboard siding requires near-constant repainting at considerable expense. Replacement of the siding with a maintenance-free alternative would eliminate the cost of repainting and enable the proper insulation of the walls resulting in more energy-efficiency and comfort. Removal of existing siding, installation of rigid foam insulation, and replacement of clapboards with high-quality vinyl siding. \$65,000

WINDOWS

Our windows are original to the building. Many of the frames are rotted, and many hinges and cranks are broken. The windows are made of single-paned glass, rendering them drafty and a source of heat loss. New windows will be insulated and energy-efficient, helping to reduce heating and cooling expenses. Repair of windows where possible and replacement where necessary. \$15,000

INSULATION

Insulate the various attic spaces with a combination of blown-in and rigid foam insulation, reducing icing problems and the associated structural damage, our heating and cooling expenses, our energy usage, and our near-constant dependence on the furnaces and air-conditioning systems. \$50,000

NURSERY and YOUTH AREAS

Reconfigure the nursery area and Youth Room. Replace existing exterior door with a more secure entrance to ensure that our infants, toddlers, and preschoolers are cared for in a secure, age-appropriate environment and our grade-schoolers have a safe, comfortable, inviting space for learning, community-building, and recreation. Construct a hallway to permit access to the Sanctuary. Install new plumbing and flooring, create additional storage areas, and repaint the nursery and youth areas. \$4,500

Campaign costs: \$36,500

Total Needed: \$276,000
