



ST. PATRICK SCHOOL TUITION REBATE PROGRAM



PURPOSE

The SPS Tuition Rebate Program is a constructive, convenient, resourceful way for SPS parents to save money to be used towards tuition.

HOW IT WORKS

Families purchase scrip (gift certificates) for national and local businesses at the face value of the certificate. SPS purchases the scrip at various discounted rates (determined by the retailer). The discounted amount is saved in a Tuition Rebate Account (through SPS) under the family's name. That amount accumulates through the school year as purchases are made. The total is then applied to the following year's tuition.

*Because the program began late in the school year, parents will be able to use accumulated funds through October towards the 2005 – 2006 school year, if they choose.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

The program is open to anyone who wants to use it. You can “designate” your funds toward a family or families who attend St. Patrick School, or toward the General Tuition Fund, which will be used for tuition assistance.

HOW DO I BEGIN?

1. Forms are available at the school office, the church office, or in the church vestibule. The information can also be found on our website at www.spsirish.org.
2. SPS families complete the Enrollment Form. Friends and parish families complete the Designate Form (to apply the discount to a specific family or the general fund).
3. Complete order form with payment for the full amount of your purchase (cash or check made out to Tuition Rebate Program).
4. Return to SPS office or church office by 9:15 a.m. Monday morning. Returns will also be accepted in the weekend collection basket marked “Scrip” or “Tuition Rebate Program”.
5. **SUMMER PICK-UP:** Orders can be picked up on Friday from 11 am – 1 pm at SPS. Other arrangements can be made, if necessary. A new order form will be enclosed with each order.
6. Discount percentage amount is applied to designated account.
7. Orders are placed every week. You can choose to place your order weekly, bi-weekly, monthly, etc.
