

SUGGESTED LETTER AND PROTOCOL FOR ELECTION INTEGRITY GROUPS, LOCAL POLLWATCHERS AND COMMITTEEPERSONS

To Pollwatchers and Committeepersons:

Enclosed are simple tools to help monitor this election, November 4, 2008

1. **POLLWATCHER GUIDELINES:** This needs to be shared by all shifts on Election Day. Do not remove guidelines from polling room. Use the guidelines to fill out the pollwatcher checklists.
2. **POLLWATCHER CHECKLIST:** 6 double-sided checklists per day recommended
3. **PROBLEM LOG:** 3-6 double-sided copies suggested.
