## **Rotary**

Rotary is the world's first service club organization and was founded in February, 1905, when young lawyer Paul P. Harris met with three friends in Chicago, Illinois. They decided to meet weekly at each member's place of business in turn. The rotation of meetings was designed to acquaint the members with one another's vocations and to promote business. Hence, the name "Rotary" was adopted.

Today, Rotary International is found in over 170 countries around the globe. The Vineland Rotary Club was founded in 1920 and is part of southern New Jersey's Rotary International District 7640. The Vineland club has approximately 75 members who meet weekly at luncheon meetings. Women and men who are leaders in the local business community are the members who join in fellowship, sharing many impressive accomplishments through Rotary's Four Avenues of

Service — Club, Vocational, Community and International. Many activities and fund raising efforts assist the club in its aggressive community assistance projects, including the scholarship program.

Rotarians believe high standards of conduct are important and they promote a simple, four-question test of the things we think, say or do:

1. Is it the Truth?
2. Is it Fair to all Concerned?
3. Will it Build Goodwill and Better Friendships?
4. Will it be Beneficial to all Concerned?

## **Vineland Rotary Scholarships**

The Vineland Rotary Club annually offers financial awards to encourage those seeking higher education and vocational training. The various scholarship awards are named in honor of outstanding Rotarians who have had a lasting positive impact on our community of Vineland. The number and amount of scholarship awards may vary from year-to-year, depending upon funds available.

### **Harry Kejzman Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000**

for a student majoring in any subject. This scholarship is open to students that are Vineland residents and students graduating from any Vineland high school including St. Augustine Prep and Our Lady of Mercy Academy or are currently attending Cumberland County College. Scholarship winners must attend Cumberland County College.

### **John Spoltre/Matt Blatt Most Inspirational Scholarship -\$2,500**

for a student majoring in any subject. This scholarship is open to students that are Vineland residents and students graduating from any Vineland high school including St. Augustine Prep and Our Lady of Mercy Academy. Students that have overcome adversity in life should apply.

**Vineland Rotary Harry D. Doerr Scholarship** - This scholarship is not restricted to college or university training, but shall also include training or schooling in non-academic fields or endeavors. Applicants and awardees may apply for additional one-year awards. Awards are made payable to the recipient and the educational provider. Doerr scholarships vary in amount, but are not usually less than \$1,000.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a United States citizen.
2. Be a high school graduate.
3. Be a Vineland resident.
4. Demonstrate positive character.
5. Demonstrate financial need.
6. Demonstrate intelligence standards.
7. Demonstrate scholastic ability.

**Vineland Rotary High School Scholarships** — Applicants shall demonstrate, by high school performance, the potential for successful college work. Scholastic standing, while important, shall be one of several factors to be considered. Applicants must have high ideals and have demonstrated integrity, purposefulness, initiative and sense of social responsibility. Employment experience will also be considered. Application deadline is April 30th.
