

Hello Cowboy Shooters

Again this year we are excited about the 11th Annual Blue Ridge Roundup. There have been some changes this year, so read carefully so we all will be on the same page, so to speak. The dates for this years Roundup are April 17, 18th and 19th.

At the SASS Convention in December of 2008 it was decided to eliminate the Modern and Traditional classes. In place of Modern and Traditional classes they put in 2 new classes. They are Cowboys- Cowgirls, and Wrangler and Lady Wrangler. These are age based classes. Cowboy class is for ages 17 to 35. Wrangler is 36 to 48. We will also offer the Modern class for those who would like to continue to shoot it, provided we have at least 3 to sign up for Modern class.

With the economy as it is we will not be having a banquet this year. The banquet attendance has been down in the past years. We are planning on having a hospitality room at the Days Inn in Raphine on Friday and Saturday evenings. We hope you can make it by the room at least one evening. Also we are looking for people to help sponsor the hospitality room.

This year we have 3 options on where to stay while shooting Roundup. We have the Natural Bridge Hotel. You can get a patio room for \$54.00 a night. Also we have the Days Inn in Lexington and Raphine. Lexington Days Inn you can get a room for \$49.95. Days Inn in Raphine is \$54.00 a night. Registration will begin at 11:00am. After events of the day we will have the hospitality room at the Days Inn Raphine.

Saturday April 18th we will begin the main match. There will be a mandatory shooters meeting at 9:00am. We will begin shooting at 9:30am. You can register Saturday morning starting at 8:00am. After the events of that day we will again have the hospitality room at the Days Inn Raphine.

Sunday April 19th we will begin shooting at 9:00am. At the conclusion of the main match we will have the awards ceremony as soon as the scores are done. We hope to start the awards ceremony at 2:30.

We will be providing lunches Saturday and Sunday for the main match shooters. Guests that want to eat will need to pay \$15.00 for both days.
