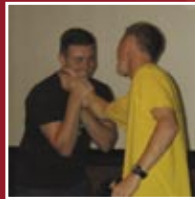

Brass

Includes student bands which rehearse daily. An optional "A Band" comprised of top instrumental students will also be formed for the challenge of advanced work. Music will be chosen from the latest available sources ranging from Christian pop to Salvation Army classics.

Vocal

Will include a women's chorus which will meet daily for rehearsals. An optional "A Chorus" (male and female mixed choir) will also be formed for challenging advanced work. Music will be chosen from a wide range of Christian contemporary, classical and Salvation Army songs.

Worship Team

The worship team will form the house band and will lead worship throughout the camp. Male and female vocalists will be backed by popular instrumentation including punch brass as needed. Spaces will be limited. A taped audition may be required.

Drama

This exciting program is designed to attract students who do not necessarily have a background in brass or vocal music. Dramatic arts are becoming recognized as a potent tool in creative ministry. The school will offer a full stream of dramatic technique. While experience would be helpful, a willing heart would be most valuable. The class will also be dedicated to practical training for application in dramatic arts ministry.
