Dr. Wayne Strouse has been a Family Practice Physician in Penn Yan for many years. He will discuss health issues that today's man needs to be aware of.



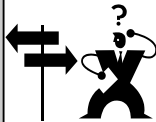

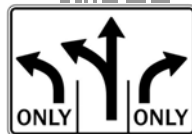
