To whom this may concern,

As a member of the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe, I am writing to you requesting your support of the Declaration that is being proposed by the Cambridge Sunshine Foundation in Cambridge, Massachusetts on the behalf of natives throughout Indian Country. Danny De Gug, the founder of CSF has prepared and structured a historical Document that declares a National Holiday Weekend in honor of the Native People of this United States. Yes, it is declared and we are asking you for your creative support to honor all Native peoples with a declaration of this National Holiday weekend, which is to be set forth to honor all of our ancestors as well as honoring those with us today of whom have been instrumental in maintaining our culture and traditions as they are today.

We, the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe are very pleased that the Cambridge Sunshine Foundation has recognized us as the tribe to represent this declaration into further action on the behalf of all Indian Country. In this effort of recognizing our people in such a glorious and respectful manner we are exceedingly pleased with the C.S.F. efforts to see this through on the behalf of such a wide body of Indian peoples. We have sent out to over 500 tribes and professionals the PDF file that has the Declaration of the National Holiday Weekend.

The Cambridge Sunshine Foundation and the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe are asking you to support this initiative by contacting all of our National and Coast to Coast Airlines, Tour Companies, Trains, and Bus Depots as well as Television and Radio Stations. Please help us by taking the time to support our efforts in making things right and fair in our democracy, by recognizing that the Native Americans were in fact here and welcomed many and taught many to simply survive and prosper.

The Supermarket Chains are now willing to share our roots by displaying our native fruits and vegetables that show honor to the millions of indigenous peoples that farmed tens of thousands of farm lands of years ago, thus showing honor and respect in a stores produce section, it may sound simple, but, we ask for not much else.

The Cambridge Sunshine Foundation is in the Media business and is working on getting all TV and Radio stations across the nation to do public service announcement about the roots of the indigenous peoples. These one minute segments will be presented by "native people" and other sensitive individuals that know and love our culture . With that; we see leaders from all walks of life in America doing these Public Service Announcements, and we encourage teachers and students to get involved and participate in some of the segments as well.

Lastly there is a request for Native Artist to assist in designing "Totem Poles" to be visible in every community and have specific input from all people young and old to be designed by talented and caring individuals who believe in the hopes and dreams of this proposed "Declaration"

If you truly understand the history of the indigenous peoples then we know you'll support this "Declaration" and we thank you!
