Our foster homes not only care for our doxies, but also evaluate them for behavioral issues (fear of men, good with other dogs, etc.) so that we can match each dog up with a perfect forever home. It takes a special kind of person to foster, for they love & care for these dogs knowing that they will eventually be placed in other homes. Did you know that your used cell phones and printer cartridges can benefit CCDR? By recycling them, CCDR receives much needed funds, and these items stay out of landfills. We collect any cell phones, ink jet or toner cartridges. We have raised \$98.90 so far in 2009 with this program, and with your help we can more than double that before the end of the year! You can drop cell phones and/or cartridges off to our booth at one of our events, or at a collection box found at one of the locations listed on our [local fundraising page](#). We can also mail out pre-paid envelopes for the ink jet cartridges and cell phones. Toner cartridges either need to be dropped off at an event, or email us to arrange pick up.
