WALTER F. KUBISTY, JR. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

GUIDELINES

1. Applicant shall be a current STUDENT member of ASQ Buffalo Section attending (in good standing) a two or four year college located in Western New York or Southern Ontario. Where membership number cannot be verified, candidate may present other alternative evidence such as a canceled check, invoice, membership application, etc., which is subject to review by the Scholarship Committee. *Note: Student membership applications enclosed with the scholarship application will be accepted at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.*
2. Previous recipients of this award and students not attending regional colleges are not eligible.
3. Complete both pages of the application. Photocopies and/or word-processor generated copies are acceptable. *Note: The Career Objective and Essay shall be typewritten. **Applications with hand written Career Objective and Essay will be rejected.***
4. Sign the application and have it endorsed by a faculty member.
5. Attach your official school transcript. Where school policy denies transcripts directly to the student, request that it be sent to the address below, and furnish evidence of your request within the application dates listed below. This shall be done every time the student applies for the scholarship.
6. Attach letters of reference from faculty, employer, etc., if desired.
7. State your career objective and complete the requested essay (page 2). Remember handwritten copies will not be considered and will not be returned.
