WHEN: Sunday, May 6th, 2007 8 AM.

WHERE: Imagination Glen Park. Portage Ave. & McCool Rd. in Portage, Indiana.

CONCEPT: A true Zoy race--low frill, high fun event. Please, whimper quietly and whine in private. If you want a smooth, fast course, accurate splits, smorgasbord dining, giant goody bags, 5-year age groups, expensive awards...this ain't your cup of water. If you want a fun, different, challenging, slightly wild, event in which to run OR walk--join us. The course will be off road and mildly extreme. Water crossings?...Maybe. WALKERS WELCOME. TEAMLESS PERSONS WELCOME DAY-OF-RACE.

SUBSTITUTES and TEAMING: All runners and walkers will get the joy and satisfaction, if they choose to accept it, of participating. If a team has to substitute a runner in any round AFTER THE RACE BEGINS, that team will not be eligible for awards. We just can't figure out how to do that fairly. If the sub wants a shirt he'll have to cough up \$10. We will have a designated place at registration for hapless would-be participants looking for prospective team members so that they might blissfully hook up. INDIVIDUALS, PLEASE COME ON RACE DAY AND FORM A TEAM.

ORDER: Each round will have 3 routes that correspond roughly with the number of miles in each route. They'll be run in order: route 1, 2, 3. The order of runners: Round A: runners xyz. Round B: runners yzx, Round C: runners zxy.

BENEFITS: Non-frilly t-shirts of some value and age to the first 150 registrants. (If we run out we'll discount your entry by \$5) Some kind of awards if you earn 'em. A few giveaways from the Human Race Sports. Other than the knowing, deep in your heart that on May 6, 2007 you did something good for your self and your team mates and fellow competitors, that's about it. It'll probably take a good team about 2 hours to "git 'er dun" this year. If you need something to eat or drink, during this longish race, you better bring it.
